Texas Safety Foundation, Inc. (TSF) was created as a division of the **Texas Safety Association** on **Sept. 18, 1964**; it was incorporated as a separate, **501(c)(3) nonprofit** on **Feb. 22, 1966**, to assist **aspiring Safety and Health Professionals**.

The **Texas Safety Foundation (TSF)** was established for the **encouragement and support of Safety and Health Education** by providing **scholarships for students entering the safety profession**. TSF supports **safety and health education and research** within the **State of Texas**.

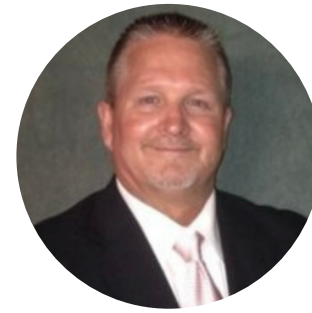

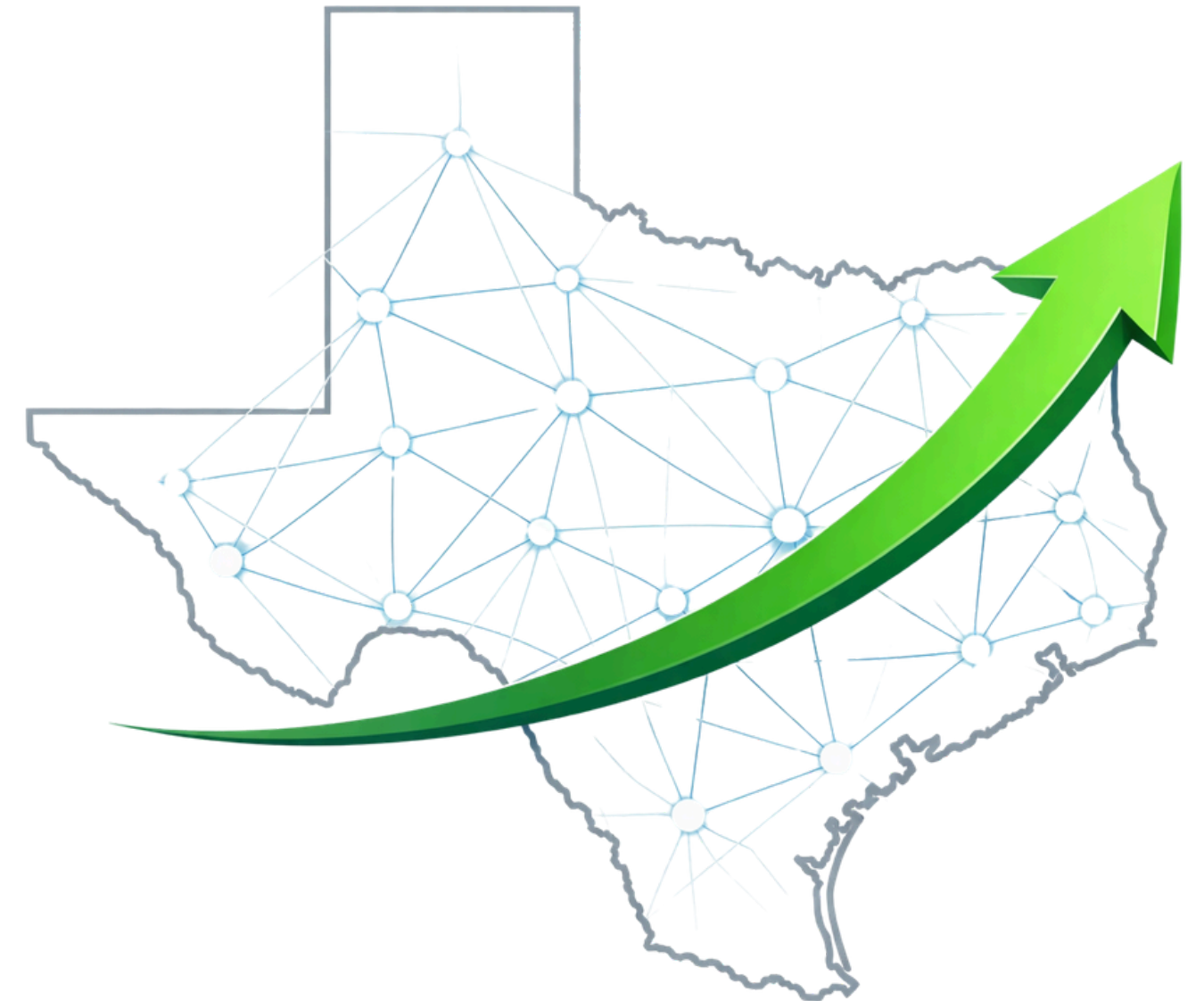
Current Partnerships

The Texas Safety Foundation, Inc. has committed **\$25,000 in funding for 2026** to support safety and health education across Texas.

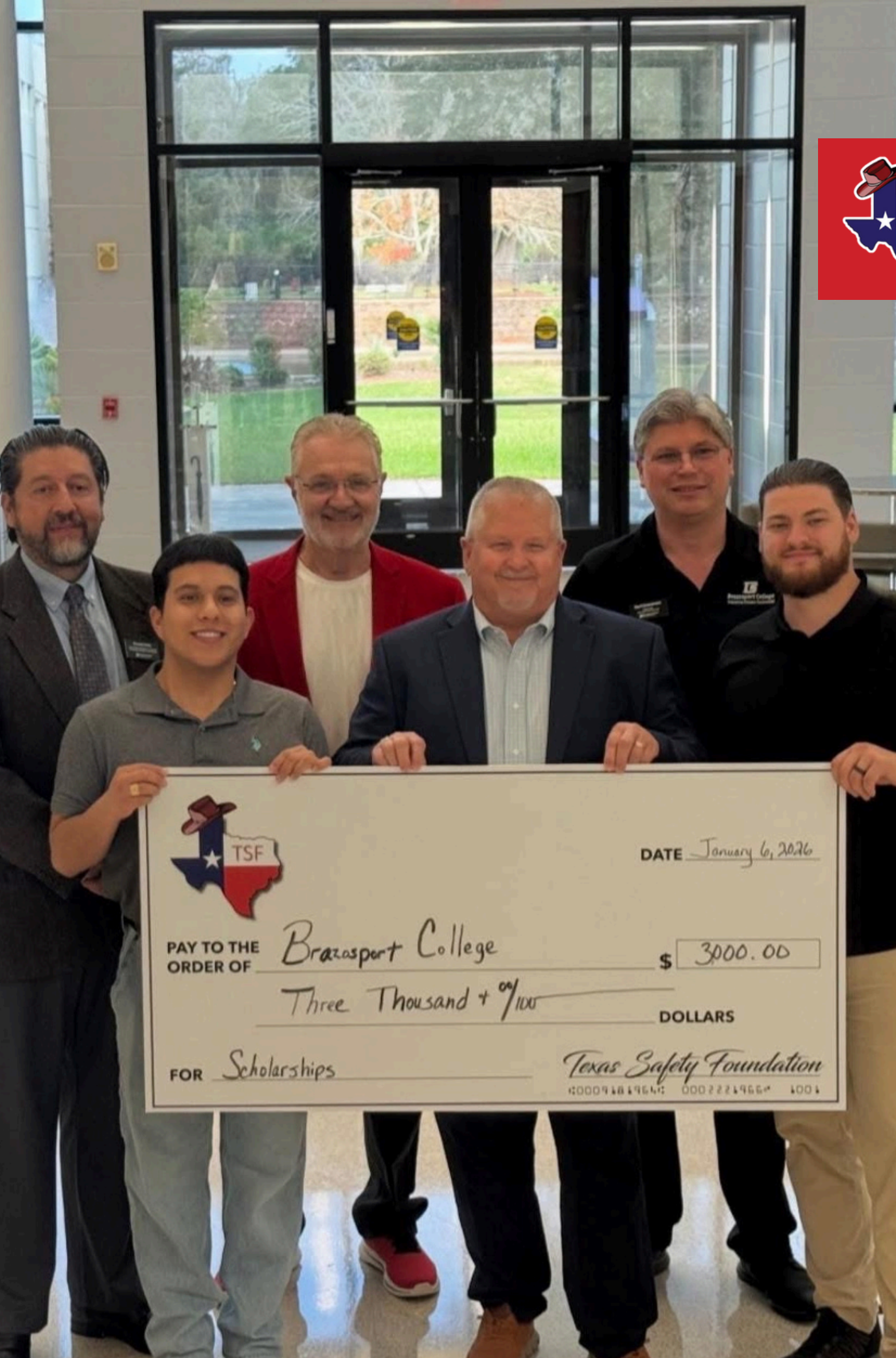
